## **Spanish for Criminal Justice Professionals #1165**

The 40 hour FDLE course is designed to provide non-Spanish speaking criminal justice professionals with the basic Spanish language skills needed to communicate criminal justice commands.

100% attendance is required and participants must achieve a minimum score of 80% on the written exam to receive a certificate of completion.

This course is salary incentive eligible or may be applied toward satisfying mandatory retraining requirements.
