Examination: Participants must achieve a minimum score of 80% on the written exam to receive a certificate of completion.

Dress Policy: Your department's authorized training uniform or business casual attire. No jeans permitted. Law enforcement personnel not in uniform that are carrying exposed firearms must prominently display agency ID and/or badge at all times while on college property.
