## Vehicle Operations Instructor Course #800

The 40 hour FDLE specialized instructor course was developed to enhance the knowledge, skills, and abilities of an individual to provide efficient and effective basic recruit vehicle operations training to criminal justice personnel.

Upon completion of this course, instructor students will be eligible for certification by the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission (CJSTC) as a high-liability instructor qualified to teach vehicle operations.

**Registration:** All HCSO personnel shall submit a training request through your chain of command. All other agencies must submit an Advanced & Specialized Training Authorization form by your training section.

**Attendance:** Attendance at the initial class is mandatory. All students must adhere to the attendance requirements of the Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission and the Rules, Policies and Procedures of the Sheriff's Training Academy.

**Examination:** Participants must achieve a passing score of at least 85% on the written end-of-course examination and successfully complete at least four out of five runs (80%) for each exercise.

**Dress Policy:** Your department's authorized training uniform or business casual attire. No jeans permitted. Law enforcement personnel not in uniform that are carrying exposed firearms must prominently display agency ID and/or badge at all times while on college property.

**Fee:** There is no fee associated with this course.
